Rules and Regulations

Tickets Available

A total of 40,000 tickets are available at \$2.00 each with maximum revenue of \$80,000 for combined draws.

The 50/50 draw will have draw & location specific tickets available for sale at the West Kelowna ReStore, 1793 Ross Road, BC, the Kelowna Restore, #800 - 2092 Enterprise Way, BC, Penticton ReStore, 2498 Skaha Lake Rd, BC, Vernon ReStore 2707C 43 Ave and 2707B 43 Ave, BC respectively. Total jackpot value for each (quarterly) draw is dependent on number of tickets sold. The winner gets half of the total jackpot. 50/50 tickets must be purchased in person at either of the five ReStores as indicated above. Habitat for Humanity reserves the right to alter the ratio of tickets available at each ReStore location to maximize ticket sales. Regardless of the location sell ratio, the total amount of available tickets and jackpot values will not exceed stated values.

Eligibility

Ticket purchaser must be 19 years of age or older. If a minor's name appears on the ticket stub the prize shall be delivered to the minor's parents, legal guardian or trustee. A non-resident of British Columbia may purchase a ticket only if the entire payment transaction takes place while the person is in British Columbia and if the ticket or a receipt is issued at that time. Tickets will not be distributed to, mailed or otherwise sent to a non-resident's third-party address in B.C.

Habitat for Humanity Okanagan employees, directors and those persons responsible for the conduct and management of the ticket raffle, including employees of contracted gaming services providers are not permitted to purchase tickets.

Chances of Winning

There is a total of 4 draws at a total of five Habitat ReStore locations as identified herein. Odds of winning depend on number of tickets sold.

Tax Information

Prizes are awarded tax-free in Canada. The price of tickets is not deductible as a charitable donation for tax purposes in Canada.



Draw Dates

Four 50/50 draws to be held as follows:

- Draw 1: Ticket sales January 1 to March 30, 2021. Draw March 31, 2021.
- Draw 2: Ticket sales April 1 to June 29, 2021. Draw June 30, 2021.
- Draw 3: Ticket sales July 1 to September 29, 2021. Draw September 30, 2021.
- Draw 4: Ticket sales October 1 to December 30, 2021. Draw December 31, 2021.
- All draws will be at 2:00 pm at 1793 Ross Rd West Kelowna, BC V1Z 3E7.
- All ticket sales will be in-person only

In the event that a winning ticket stub lists more than one name, the licensee will award the prize to any individual whose name is listed on the stub. The licensee (Habitat for Humanity Okanagan) is not responsible for resolving any disputes that may arise between different individuals whose names are on the ticket stub.

Prizes must be accepted as awarded. No substitutions permitted. Winners have 1 year from draw date to claim their prize. Unclaimed prizes will be donated to a beneficiary approved by the Gaming Branch.

Awarding of Prizes

There are 4 prizes available to be won. To claim a prize, prize winners must provide the following before the prize is awarded:

- a. Signature on the prize acceptance sheet.
- b. Winning ticket stub.
- c. Copy of valid government issued photo identification
