How it works

1 - The teams that have paid their \$600 registration fee and have secured their build slot by the deadline on November 15, 2023, will build their gingerbread houses at the Laurel Packing House on Wednesday, November 22, 2023.

2 - The teams understand that there will be opportunities to donate to Habitat for Humanity Okanagan to buy building violations on other teams or to enhance your own building efforts.

3 - Each participating team will receive a gingerbread house and village building kit. This includes your gingerbread house, your gingerbread village, and it will include the candy and icing that comes from each kit. Teams can bring their own tools to use. (Teams can also buy an extra gingerbread kits along with candy and icing for a set price.)

4 - Given that some people may have allergies – all gingerbread building projects must be peanut and nut-free. Food colouring is allowed.







5 - Each team will be provided the same amount of time unless you are issued a violation from Gingy. You will have approximately 2 hours of build time from start to finish. Building will start at 6:30 pm and will end at 8:30 pm.

6 - Each team is limited to 5 team members, this includes your project manager.

7 - All gingerbread houses must be built on your official Jingle Bell Build board that each team will be provided on build night.

8 - No artificial interior materials, such as styrofoam or wood, are to be used to construct or decorate on your build. Nonedible decorations, such as paint, ribbon, figurines, etc., may be used to decorate your gingerbread build.

9 - Eating an opponent's house is not allowed.

10 - Most important rule: everyone should have as much fun as possible!

Beware of the Gingy Violations

Buy an extra Gingerbread Kit \$25.00 Off the street candy permit \$10.00

• Add more candy to your build. Grab items you forgot you needed.

10 minute work stoppage **\$25.00** Return to work permit **\$50.00**

- Give double to cancel the work stoppage
- Secret ingredient Pick one! \$10.00

Safety first violation - Wear your work

gloves \$10.00

Team members must work with their work gloves on for 10 minutes (1 per team)

Hard hat violation \$10.00

• Teams have to wear funny hats issued by Gingy

Lefty loosey, Righty tighty violation \$25.00

• Each team member must work for 10 minutes with one hand behind their back! (1 per team)

Grinch napping violation \$20.00

• Steal 1 member of another team to help you build (1 x only)

Zoning Violation \$25.00

• According to By-law #4346 - it states that no Gingerbread building or Gingerbread structure shall be erected where not permitted. your team is hereby ordered to make a permit application to the Gingy Committee of Adjustment to legalize the use of your Gingerbread structure.
